# Winter Track 2021-2022 Season Summary

The Girls Winter Track team accomplished so much this season! Not only were they finally able to run in indoor track facilities again, but many girls were able to set amazing personal records, place in very competitive meets, and even set some school records.

The season started with the Somerset County Relays. A lot of top runners were missing from this meet due to COVID, but the overall highlight of the meet had to be from Sara Sahadi who placed 2nd in Shot Put by throwing 33-8.5. Next came the Frosh-Soph Relays where they placed 1st in the DMR, 4x800, and 4x400. A great way to start off the season! The first meet of the season for a lot of athletes was the Group 4 Relays. Kiera McCombs placed first in Pole Vault, Maura Medenilla placed 4th in High Jump, and the 4x800 team placed 5th.



The Skyland Conference Championship brought a lot of medals! Maura Medenilla had a big day by placing 2nd in the 400, 5th in the 800, and winning High Jump! Grace LaCapra also placed in the 800 with a 6th place finish. Kiera McCombs and Annika Svensson earned 2nd and 5th in Pole Vault, and Sara Sahadi and Aarna Mishra placed 2nd and 6th in Shot Put. The day closed with the 4x400 team placing 5th! A very good way to begin championship season for the girls!

A quick trip to New York served the girls 4x800 team of Annika Svensson, Maura Medenilla, Samantha Shimsky, and Grace LaCapra well as they qualified for Nationals by running 9:37.83!

By far the best meet of the season had to be the State Section where the girls team won for the 8th season in a row. Medals went to Maura in the 400, 800, and High Jump, Grace in the 1600, Annika in Pole Vault, Sammie in the 1600 and 3200, and the 4x400 team. Sectional Champions included Kiera McCombs in the Pole Vault and Sara Sahadi in Shot Put. Not only was Kiera McCombs a Sectional Champion, but just a few days later, she set the Indoor Pole Vault school record by jumping 10-4 at Hunterdon Central!

Then it was back to Toms River for Groups! Sara, Kiera, and



Maura once again dominated the meet by placing 6th in Shot Put, 3rd in Pole Vault, and 6th in the 400. This earned each of them, and the 4x800 team, a spot at the following week's Meet of Champions. Meet of Champions had many noteworthy performances! Sara set a school record in the Shot Put and earned herself 6th place in the state with a throw of 39-2! Kiera jumped her way to 6th in Pole Vault as well. Lastly, the 4x800 placed 3rd with one more week left of practice before heading back to New York to compete at New Balance Nationals.

Overall, the team was so happy to finally return to a "normal" season

following a year of Polar Bear meets and checking temperatures. The team is so proud of all the girls for working so hard and pushing themselves to their limits this season! Congratulations to all our athletes! We can't wait to see them back for Spring Track!
